## WE APPRECIATE OUR PARENT VOLUNTEERS!!

Dear Parents,

In the past the Kuna School District, used a name based background check to screen all volunteers. This screening tool cost the volunteer \$20.

Recently law has recognized 2 types of volunteers and thus removed the need for the \$20 background check.

Category 1: A volunteer who will be supervised by a KSD staff member and never alone with child or on an overnight trip. **(examples: field trip chaperone, classroom helper, office help)** Now there is no money required.

To be a Category 1 Volunteer at our school, please fill out a volunteer application at: "[www.kunaschools.org](http://www.kunaschools.org)".

The KSD HR Dept will then screen your application and notify the school when you are cleared to volunteer.

Category 2: A volunteer who at times is unsupervised by a staff member alone with children, or may be on overnight trips. **(examples: all athletic coach volunteers, a parent on an overnight trip with students)**

To be a Category 2 Volunteer you will need to complete following requirements:

A. Fill out a volunteer application at: "[www.kunaschools.org](http://www.kunaschools.org)"

B. Go to KSD HR Dept to pick up a fingerprint card and take it to the ISP in Meridian to be fingerprinted (cost \$10).

C. Then return your fingerprint card to KSD HR Dept along with a required check for \$30.75.


D. Once the background check is complete the HR Dept will notify the school regarding your status.

If you will be a guest speaker, in for a one-time class or an assembly, there is no background check required.

If you have already had a background check done within the Kuna School District, you are grandfathered into this policy and do not need to fill out the new volunteer application.
